

## Klondike Kids Club: An afterschool program, helping children succeed:

As a student with an interest in teaching, and a heart for children: YOU, can make a difference in the life of a child THIS YEAR as a volunteer at the Klondike Kids Club.

Klondike Kids Club is located in the Community Room of Point West Mobil Home Community, located on Klondike Road. KKC is a collaborative effort of Klondike Elementary School, First United Methodist Church and Point West Management.

The Club serves the children of Point West in grades kindergarten through fifth. Children are divided into two groups: K-3 and 4-5. Each group meets two days a week from 4:00-5:30, when Tippecanoe School Corporation is in session. KKC does not meet when school is canceled for weather events.

For many of the children, English is a second language, which means that often they need extra help and encouragement with homework assignments. Parents are frequently unable to help their children because of a language barrier. Many families that we serve are the recipients of the government's free and reduced lunch program.

Volunteers are asked to commit to one day each week and may choose their preferred day and age level.

Monday/Wednesday: Grades 4 & 5

Tuesday/Thursday: Grades Kindergarten-3
